I. The Grace of God Gives Hope For Any Who Feels **Unloved (Vs. 4)**

- **God** loved these Corinthians - He sent His Son.
- **Christ** loves these Corinthians - He died that they might live.
- **Paul** loves Corinthians - He thanked God for them.
- And God loves **you!**

II. The Grace of God Gives Hope For Any Who Feel **Unable (Vss. 5,6; Zech. 4:6)**

NOTE: Verse 6 literally means, “Even so [you now see] that the preaching we did about Christ was proved real by what happened to you.”

ENRICHED - made wealthy, given more that you **need**.

UTTERANCE - (Gk. logos) Your collective words, **expression**, communication.

KNOWLEDGE - what you **perceive**, come to know.

III. The Grace of God Gives Hope For Any Who Feel **Unfulfilled (Vs. 7)**

- God has a purpose and plan for each of us.
- He wants us to know it more than we want to know it.

IV. The Grace of God Gives Hope For Any Who Feel **Unworthy (Vss. 8,9; Col. 2:7; Rom. 7:22-25)**

CONFIRM – *bebaino*. To **stabilitate**. Strong’s
